ENTRY FEE: PRE – \$20 per test **DAY OF EVENT** – \$25 per test **JUNIOR DISCOUNT** – \$5 off per test

SCHEDULE – **First dog for Test 1 runs at 8:15 am.** Schedule will be emailed to entrants. Dogs will run in groups and each group will complete Test 1 and then will do Test 2. Day of entry entrants will run where there is group availability.

FETCH INFORMATION

AKC Fetch is a pass-fail non-competitive test that assesses the ability of a dog to retrieve.

There are 4 levels of Fetch – Novice, Intermediate, Advanced, and Retriever. A dog must pass the test twice at each level to earn a title for that level.

If a dog passes the Fetch Dog test on two occasions, the owner may apply for the AKC Fetch title. Upon application with AKC, the Fetch title will be applied to the dog's record and will appear on the dog's AKC title record and name. The title certificate will be mailed to the dog's primary owner of record.

AWARDS

Each dog which passes the test will receive a qualifying ribbon. Dogs that have successfully passed their second test will receive a new title ribbon.

REFUNDS & CANCELLATIONS

No entry fee will be refunded if the test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Test Committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Test Committee. Entries withdrawn for any reason after closing date are not eligible for a refund. Tests will proceed rain or shine.

Cancellation of entries must be in writing and received prior to the stated close of entries. A full refund will be issued.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Dogs must be on leash at all times while on the test grounds.

CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG!!!!

Bring your own ball or bumper.

Dogs may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, or harnesses during the test. Dogs may wear slip collars, buckle collars, or martingales. Leash should be 4' to 6' long and made of fabric, biothane, or leather.

Dogs and/or handlers with physical disabilities are welcome.

The use of food or clickers are not permitted. The use of "imaginary food" as a lure is not permitted.

Bitches in season will test at the end of the day. Please notify secretary if your dog is in season.

Any sign of aggression is an automatic disqualification.

Dogs may be excused by judge for excessive delay during the test, being found unfit to compete, interference with the test in progress by owner or handler, or not being present when called.

Dogs that soil the test area do not qualify.

No dogs are allowed in the testing area until their testing time.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the test area when it is scheduled to be evaluated. The hosting club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system, stewards, or runners for the purpose of calling and/or locating dogs that are not brought to the test area when required.

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform the Temperament test safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the event site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The American Kennel Club, Mid-Continent Kennel Club, SkyWass Ranch, and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The host reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the American Kennel Club, Mid-Continent Kennel Club, SkyWass Ranch, or any official thereof.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this trial.
